<p><u>Visualizing</u></p> <p>As you read the poem, visualize the setting. After reading, illustrate the setting and write a paragraph explaining why you pictured things in that way.</p>	<p><u>Figurative Language</u></p> <p>Find a piece of figurative language (simile, metaphor, idiom, etc..) in the poem. Explain what it means.</p>	<p><u>Letter</u></p> <p>Write a letter to the author of the poem telling them how the poem made you feel and why.</p>
<p><u>Comic</u></p> <p>Create a comic strip to show what happens in the poem.</p>	<p><u>Rhyming Words</u></p> <p>Rewrite the poem, writing the rhyming words in a different color.</p>	<p><u>Questions and Answers</u></p> <p>Create 5 questions in at least 2 formats (multiple choice, fill in the blank, true/false, short answer). Include an answer key with the questions.</p>
<p><u>Theme</u></p> <p>What is the theme of the poem? Support your answer with details from the text. Then, create a visual picture to represent the theme of the poem.</p>	<p><u>New Ending</u></p> <p>Rewrite the poem, adding a new, creative ending. You can replace the ending stanza, or add one to the end.</p>	<p><u>Poetry Review</u></p> <p>Write a review of the poem. Be sure to include what you think about the poem, why you think that, and why others should or should not read the poem.</p>
